As a resident of unit 2 79-85 brougham st I have to strongly disapprove of this proposal for various points:

- The location is extremely ill-advised getting in the middle of a walking path that is frequently used. As well the walking area is frequently inaccessible as a result of constant illegal dumping that has not led to any prosecution or any attempts to stop it. This would be a further impediment for those with mobility issues or disabilities.

- These toilets would only encourage the homeless population to descend onto here, and the last thing this area needs is more of this issue. It would only make the area more unwelcoming as a result.

- There is not a demand for this from the local residents, everyone lives nearby and can use their own home facilities if they require it.

Please reconsider this plan.

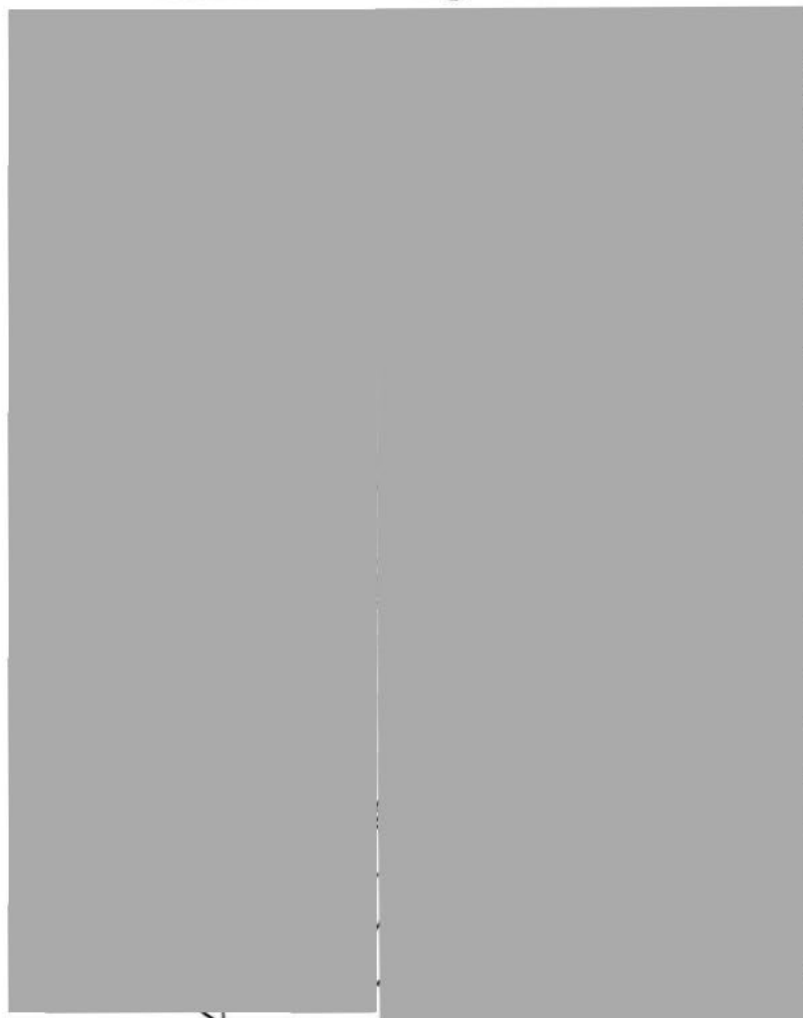

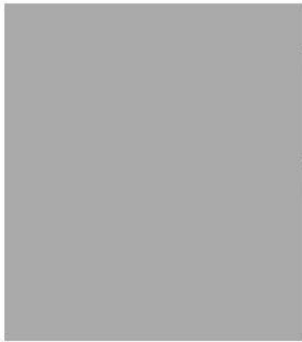

Dear Daniel

I am a resident of Woolloomooloo at 115 Brougham St and recently heard about this proposal. For context, I work in the city and walk through this place each day and I have two young children who play in the playground.

Our family definitely welcomes an upgraded public toilet in the area but we are concerned that the currently proposed location disregards the usage of the area. In particular this is a thoroughfare so it would be extremely awkward to have a toilet in the way — almost everyone in Potts Point who walks to the city walks down Butler Stairs then through that square. Tourists and partygoers from the wharf also walk through that place up to Potts Point. The existing public toilet is in a less obtrusive space that interrupts normal foot traffic and visual amenity less. It is also not an attractive sight / smell to have to walk past each time I take my children to the playground. It also has the potential to encourage partygoers to hang out in that square which would make the area louder and less clean, and may attract antisocial behaviour.

I would be very grateful to understand the extent to which other sites have been considered in the area including the existing site or other sites down near Harry's Cafe de Wheels? Has the integration of this proposal with the revised playground also been considered?
